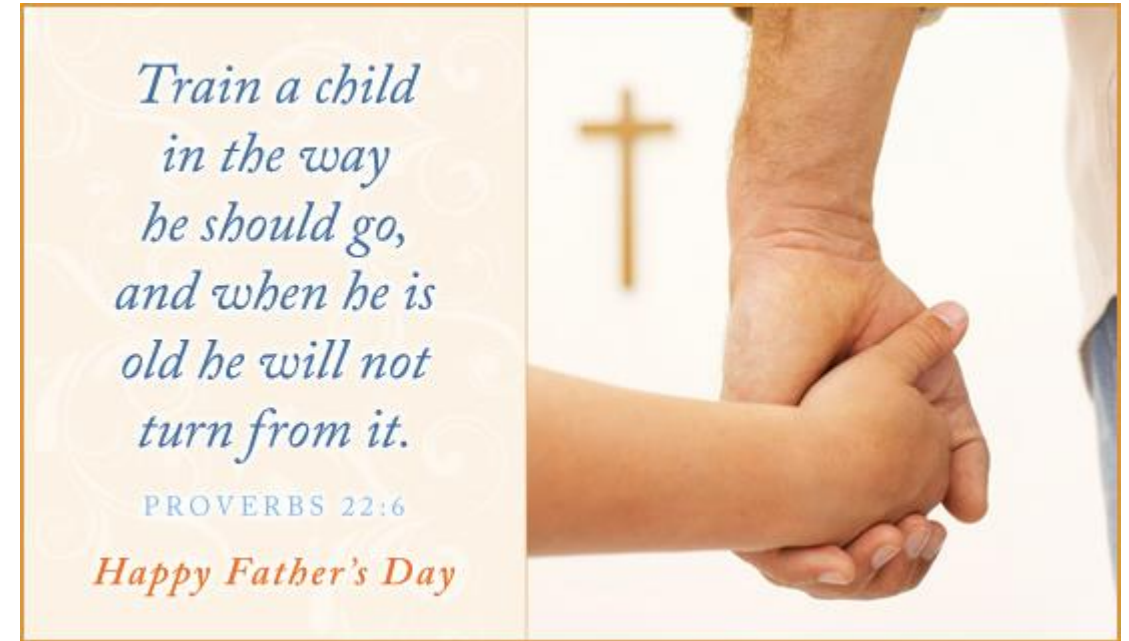

**MIRACLE JARS** – The first six years of life are key to a child's healthy educational and social development. *Our Miracle Jar money for the month of June* is going to **Jasper County First Steps**, a new project for the Mission Team. First Steps connects Jasper County's high risk preschool children to coordinated, individualized interventions using programs and strategies to help their youngest learners get ready for school. South Carolina's First Steps program was created by law in 1999. Some of the strategies they use are parent home visitation to provide parent education in regards to school readiness, Dolly Parton Imagination Library (one book per month for all Jasper County children between ages of 0–5), child care training, summer home visits to get children ready for kindergarten, early identification and referral for children with delays in development.



A new project this spring for First Steps is the creation of 16 **Little Free Libraries** (thank you Sun City for building and painting them!) that have been placed around Jasper County. **They are in need of book donations** for preschool and older children. Little tubs will be on both sides of the narthex doors for your donations (used or new). Thank you!!!!

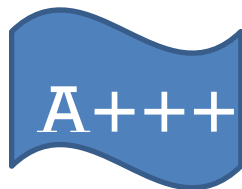
