Volunteers are trained according to those guidelines. We are contracted with four facilities and have 21 volunteers. There are currently 30 residents waiting for volunteers. **UNIFORMS FOR HARDEEVILLE ELEMENTARY** – The Mission Team is again collecting uniforms (pants and shirts), underwear, socks and belts for Hardeeville Elementary School in Jasper County. Many of these children come to school with pants that are ripped; zippers don't work and are too big or small. They wear shirts with holes in them or are so stained beyond what any amount of washing will clean. They have no socks or belts. Often times when a child has an accident, there is no way to reach a parent (or the parent has no transportation) to come and bring clean clothes, so the school has to provide clean clothes. Several of our church members worked and volunteered in Jasper County and have experienced these problems first hand. It is hard to believe these problems exist, especially being so close to home.

We are collecting pants and shirts (sizes 4 – 12) and also underwear, socks and belts. Navy shirts are acceptable and we need some larger sizes (12-16) this year as well. The uniform pants must be navy blue or khaki, and the shirts light blue or white with no emblems or printing on them. **Sunday, August 26<sup>th</sup> will be the last day to donate clothes.**

Sunday school will resume the Sunday after Labor Day – September 9<sup>th</sup>.

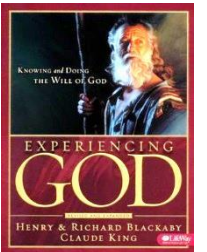
