**MIRACLE JARS** – February’s Miracle Jar donations are going to the **Pregnancy Center & Clinic of the Low Country**, the only free prenatal medical clinic within 100 miles. This is a nondenominational, prolife clinic that supports pregnant women financially and emotionally through their 16<sup>th</sup> week of pregnancy. The center offers 22 free programs and assisted more than 4,000 individuals last year throughout Beaufort and Jasper counties. It costs approximately \$408 per person for ultrasounds, counseling, prenatal care and education, providing layettes and diapers. They ask all women to go to Bible study once a month. There is one building on Hilton Head and a mobile unit that covers Hardeeville, Bluffton and Ridgeland. This center has been in operation since 1989. <http://www.pregnancycenterhhi.org>
